



I am so incredibly excited for you to go to camp and I wanted to make sure you know everything you need to before we leave. Below I've jotted down some things you'll really want to make sure you bring as well as some things to leave at home. Before we get into that, let's talk about the schedule. We will leave the parking lot at CHS at noon on Friday the 13th. If you go to Manson Middle School, no problem, you don't have school that day. If you go to Chelan, you'll need to have a note from your parents to get out early that day. I will be there at 11:15am, when you get out for lunch. Please be there no later than 11:45am.

At CHS I will give you the low down on the weekend and make sure we have everyone. After that we'll load up and take off. I can't guarantee you'll get to sit with all your friends on the way over but I promise you'll get to sit with at least one of them. We will only stop once on our way to camp at the top of Snoqualmie or North Bend to go potty. Then we'll head off to camp. On Sunday, we will leave camp around 11:30-12:00pm and be home around 4:00-4:30pm. We'll have a quick stop to grab lunch and gas up then way home. We'll also have you call home and give your parents a more accurate arrival time once we've hit Wenatchee. Bring: Sleeping bag and pillow, Bible, (if you have one) Several changes of clothes, Warm jacket (waterproof if you have one), Active Footwear (more than one pair), Toiletries, Towel, Flashlight and a little bit of Cash (for the camp store and lunch on the way home). It's always wet at camp and things don't dry out so more is always better.
